Orange County Choppers. For millions upon millions, those three words have come to signify creative brilliance administered by men who wear their raw emotions on their sleeves. Joy. Anger. Comedy. It all comes through on the Discovery Channel's runaway hit series *American Chopper*...the exploits of the Teutuls, where a father and his sons build the kind of machines dreams are made of.

Were the Teutuls – Paul, Sr., Paulie and Mikey – content to be savvy businessmen, they would make a beautiful product and market it. But with these guys, there's a lot more to it than just business. Their passion – and heart – show through. It shows through with motorcycles like the NY Fire Department 9/11 bike, and the POW/MIA bike, and the Statue of Liberty bike. When they thrill neighborhood children with the Christmas bike, you know these guys are something special. Is it any wonder, therefore, that the Teutuls decided that they wanted to have an auction...and give the proceeds away!

Touched by a visit to the Walter Reed Medical Center where Senior and his sons met returning wounded soldiers, the men decided to do what they could to support our troops in Iraq and Afghanistan. From the many worthy non-profit organizations doing good work with our troops and their families, two groups – the *Intrepid Fallen Heroes Fund* and the *Fisher House Foundation* – were chosen to be the recipients of the rewards from the Teutuls' labor. And so it is that Guernsey's is honored to be working with the men of Orange County Choppers in the presentation of their *Support Our Troops Auction*.

THE INTREPID FALLEN HEROES FUND

The Intrepid Fallen Heroes Fund provides unrestricted grants to the families of military personnel who have given their lives in the current operations in defense of our country. The gifts, \$10,000 to each dependent family and an additional \$5,000 per child, are intended to help these families through any immediate or long-term financial difficulties they may face. This gift is made quietly and without fanfare, to protect the privacy of the families. The goal of the Fund is to support them in their time of need, and to ensure that they know that our nation appreciates the sacrifice they have made for us.

The Intrepid Fallen Heroes Fund is supported entirely by donations. 100% of contributions from the public for this effort go to support military families; no administrative costs are deducted. The Fund is a program of the Intrepid Foundation, which absorbs all administrative costs.

Since 2000 the Fund has helped hundreds of military families. The Intrepid Fallen Heroes Fund contribution is given without restriction, available for any needs the family may have. This gift has helped these families in many ways: providing a sufficient down payment for a house, flying parents to the funeral of their fallen child, providing schooling for children, and even more immediate needs such as buying food and other necessities. Some families have put the funds in a trust for their children's education.

THE FISHER HOUSE FOUNDATION

The Fisher House program is a unique private-public partnership that supports America's military in their time of need. The program recognizes the special sacrifices of our men and women in uniform and the hardships of military service by meeting a humanitarian need beyond that normally provided by the Departments of Defense and Veterans Affairs.

Because members of the military and their families are stationed worldwide and must often travel great distances for specialized medical care, Fisher House Foundation donates "comfort homes," built on the grounds of major military and VA medical centers. These homes enable family members to be close to a loved one at the most stressful times – during the hospitalization for an unexpected illness, disease, or injury.

There is at least one Fisher House at every major military medical center to assist families in need and to ensure that they are provided with the comforts of home in a supportive environment. Annually, the Fisher House program serves more than 8,500 families, and have made available more than 1,500,000 days of lodging to family members since the program originated in 1990. Based on a comparison of fees at a Fisher House with commercial lodging facilities in the same area, it is estimated that families have saved nearly \$60 million by staying at a Fisher House since the program began.

In addition to constructing new houses, Fisher House Foundation continues to support existing Fisher Houses and helps individual military families in need.

1 American Flag Artwork

"God Bless America presented to Orange County Choppers Inspiring the American Dream." This has hung proudly in OCC's "Old Shop" (original location in Rock Tavern) for nearly three years. The frame is signed by Paul Sr., Paul Jr., and Mikey. 18 x 25

2 Paul Sr. "Action Figure" Orange County Choppers

An OCC fan created this in 2003. This figure was displayed in OCC's "Old Shop" in Rock Tavern for almost two years. Mounted on a stand and signed by Paul Sr. 18 1/2

3 Napa Gas Tank from American Chopper

This gas tank and frame was a mock-up for the recently-built Napa Bike. A different tank was used, but this was the original concept. Signed by Paul Sr., Paul Jr. and Mikey.

4 Side View Mirror from Paul Sr.'s Ford Explorer

This mirror came from the Ford Explorer that Senior destroyed on an episode of American Chopper earlier this season when OCC was moving out of its old location in Rock Tavern (to entertain the OCC staff in blowing off some steam during the stressful move). Senior used the Explorer to ram into walls in the old shop, much to the delight of OCC employees, who then joined in the hijinx! Signed by Paul Sr.

5 Mikey's Achieve New Balance Sneakers

Mikey's size 13 sneakers worn on American Chopper during ENTIRE first and second seasons. Mikey also wore these in most of the many photos shoots for the show and other promotions during the first two seasons. These were reluctantly retired in lieu of new sandals. Obviously one of a kind! Both sneakers and their box are signed by Mikey.

5A Mikey Original Drawing of Paul Sr.

Stick figure drawing by Mikey on Orange County Choppers "Important Stuff" notepaper. Mikey has depicted Senior standing next to a barbell saying "These bikes better get finish[ed] or else."

5B Mikey Original Drawing of Paul Sr. and Rick

Stick figure drawing by Mikey on Orange County Choppers "Important Stuff" notepaper. Mikey has depicted Senior and Rick working together on a bike.

5C Mikey Original Drawing of Mikey and Earle

Stick figure drawing by Mikey on Orange County Choppers "Important Stuff" notepaper. The drawing shows Mikey and Earle introducing themselves.

5D Mikey Original Drawing of Christian and Paulie

Stick figure drawing by Mikey on Orange County Choppers "Important Stuff" notepaper. Mikey has depicted Christian and Paulie "working in harmony."

6 Orange County Choppers Mikey's adidas Shorts

Mikey's famous (or infamous?) adidas shorts worn year-round (even through the harsh winters of upstate New York!) during the ENTIRE first season. These were retired after he found them in navy. Autographed by Mikey.

7 Red Fuel Tank with OCIW Painting

This has been hanging in Orange County Choppers' "Old Shop" (original location) in Rock Tavern since it opened. This was hand-painted over seven years ago, and depicts Paul Sr. The gas tank on the drawing of the bike says "OCIW" for "Orange County Iron Works," a steel fabrication company started by Paul Sr. many years prior to OCC, and now run by another son, Danny Teutul. Signed by Paul Sr. 20 x 8 x 10

8 Red Fuel Tank with OCIW Painting

This has been hanging in OCC's "Old Shop" (original location) in Rock Tavern since it opened. This was hand-painted over seven years ago, and depicts Paul Jr. The I-beam in the painting says "OCIW" for "Orange County Iron Works," a steel fabrication company started by Paul Sr. many years prior to OCC, and now run by another son, Danny Teutul. Signed by Paul Jr. 20 x 8 x 10

9 Campo Liberty Bike Face Sculpture

This Statue of Liberty face was welded by Mike Campo on episode 1 of the Liberty Bike build (aired April 2004). OCC chose not to use this on the bike at the last minute. This piece was a focal part of that episode, as Mike spent several days welding this. Once it was completed, Paul Sr., Paul Jr. and Winnie were all in agreement that it just didn't "fit." 15 1/2 x 10 1/2 x 7

10 Miniature Fire Bike by OCC Fan

This miniature replica of OCC's famous Fire Bike was sent to OCC by a fan, and on display in OCC's original shop in Rock Tavern. Great detail, and obviously one of a kind – like the original Fire Bike. This is made out of solid metal and is quite heavy. Signed by Paul Sr. 7 x 15

11 Orange County Choppers Boxing Dummy

This was sent to OCC by a fan, and "lived" in the OCC Rock Tavern shop for the entire first season. He has made numerous appearances on the show – providing stress relief to many. He was once dressed up like Paul Sr. and beat up by the entire OCC crew. The head is made of a thick rubber. The dummy has been autographed by Paul Sr., Paul Jr., Mikey, Winnie, Rick, and Cody. 69 tall

12 Orange County Choppers Paul Sr. Red Shirt

One of Paul Sr.'s oldest and most famous "cut-off" work shirts. Worn for years until it was retired for the OCC-brand sleeveless work shirt he now wears. The shirt has been autographed by Paul Senior.

13 "Rally Round the Flag, Boys" Woodcut

Original antique woodcut from Harper's Illustrated Weekly, October 1864. Archivaly framed. An explanatory article reads: "The constitutional standard-bearer... is represented surrounded by his gallant fellow-citizens of the army and navy, who on land and sea have maintained the honor and integrity of the nation... Soldiers... I thank you in behalf of the country for the services you have rendered... The war is for the perpetuation of the principle of equal rights to all... This is your war... Boys, rally round your Flag!" This item has been generously donated by Seth Kaller, Inc. Frame 29 1/2 x 21 1/2, Image 22 x 14

14 Orange County Choppers Snap-on Tool Cart

Another item presented by Snap-On while Orange County Choppers was building the Snap-On bike. Used extensively in both the old shop and the new shop for the past 1 1/2 years. Has one shelf and one drawer. Autographed by Paul Senior, Paul Junior, and Mikey. 30 x 36 1/2 x 15

15 Orange County Choppers Snap-on Hydraulic Bike Lift

This item was donated by Snap-On when OCC was building the Snap-On bike. This is a CUSTOM-MADE lift to fit OCC's extra-long choppers. This lift has been featured in countless episodes of American Chopper, and has been used by Cody for the past several months for his work. Autographed by Paul Senior, Paul Junior, Mikey, and Cody. The ramp shown in photos of the lift is not included. The lift will need to be shipped or picked up from OCC shop in Montgomery, New York. Should the winning bidder wish to pick up the item a tour of the shop will be included. 112 x 27

16 Handy Bike Lift from Orange County Choppers

This is one of Paul Sr.'s first lifts for the bikes in the shop. It was recently retired in lieu of a stretched out version to accommodate Orange County Choppers' longer bikes. Autographed by Paul Senior, Paul Junior, and Mikey. The lift will need to be shipped or picked up from OCC shop in Montgomery, New York. Should the winning bidder wish to pick up the item a tour of the shop will be included. 94 x 24

17 Fireman's Bike Swing Arm Prototype

This is a prototype for the Fire Bike – a swing arm. A similar one was used on the actual bike. Both ladders are detachable. 26 1/2 x 19 x 15

18 Orange County Choppers Fundraising Sign

This sign was used by Orange County Choppers to raise money for the Taylor Wenlink Foundation. Taylor, who recently passed away, was a young girl who had cancer. OCC joined with the town of Montgomery (NY) to hold a fundraiser for her. The foundation which bears her name still assists young cancer patients. The sign has been autographed by Paul Senior, Paul Junior, and Mikey. 41 x 34

19 Orange County Chopper "Nasty" Wheel

This wheel was designed by OCC artist/designer Jason Pohl for the Hooters Bike. Identical wheels are on that bike.

20 "Victory Wheels, Inc." Rims Gift Certificate

This gift certificate is for four "Victory Wheels, Inc." rims for a passenger car or SUV. "Victory Wheels, Inc." is one of the premier manufacturers of aftermarket wheel rims. This oversized certificate (18" x 36") can be redeemed at any "Victory Wheels, Inc." retailer in the U.S. (visit www.victorywheels.com for rim styles and dealer locations). The certificate has also been signed by Paul Sr. The winning bidder can keep the certificate and have the retailer stamp the certificate. This item has been generously donated by Speedway Children's Charities (www.speedwaycharities.org).

21 Orange County Choppers Junior's Dream Bike Axel Cover

This test piece (an axel cover) was created on the waterjet machine for Paul Jr.'s Dream Bike, which aired this past March. 11 3/4 x 4 x 1/4

22 OCC Junior's Dream Bike Shifter Linkage

This shifter linkage was created on the waterjet machine as a mock for a piece on Paul Jr.'s Dream Bike, which aired this past March. 16 x 4 x 1/2

23 OCC Junior's Dream Bike Forward Control

This forward control was created on the waterjet machine as a mock for a piece on Paul Jr.'s Dream Bike, which aired on American Chopper this past March. 13 x 3 3/4 x 1/8

24 Piece From the Spider Bike

This was a mock-up of a piece for the Spider Bike. A similar one was used on the actual bike. Cut with OCC's flow jet machine. 13 1/2 x 3 1/2 x 1/8

25 Orange County Choppers Suicide Shifter

This is a suicide shifter for a client bike – this particular one was not used, but an identical piece is on the bike. "out Ralph" is written on the verso. Typical of the intricate detail of OCC's one-of-a-kind designs. 15 1/4 x 10 x 1/2

26 Orange County Choppers Paul Sr. Fire Bike Mini-Toolbox

Paul Sr. made this mini-toolbox to go on the Fire Bike. Paul Jr. argued not to include it on the Fire Bike. This resulted in a huge argument on episode 1 of the Fire Bike build, perhaps one of OCC's best known bikes. This box is signed by Paul Sr. and is of great sentimental value to him, as the Fire Bike was one of the most emotional builds ever for the OCC crew. 8 x 3 1/2 x 4

27 American Chopper Lincoln Stencil

A mock sample of the gas tank cover grill for the Lincoln Bike (aired February 2005). An identical piece is used on the actual Lincoln Bike, and this was part of both episodes. 21 x 5 1/2

28 Inscribed Print of "Death Dealer"

Limited edition giclee of "Death Dealer" by Frank Frazetta. Inscribed: "To the best bike builders I've seen. Hopefully one day we can combine our minds and create the death dealer ride" and signed "F. Frazetta" in gold-toned metallic ink. Framed and numbered 57/300. 28 3/4 x 21 1/4 sight 22 x 14

29 "Webster" Wheel from Paulie's Dream Bike

This is from a big segment of Paul Jr.'s Dream Bike (American Chopper aired in March 2005), where the wheel was created for the bike, and the waterjet machine broke down. Jason Pohl (OCC artist/designer) had to reset the machine and re-create the wheel – this situation was a dominant theme of that episode. This same exact design is on Junior's Dream Bike. There is a small amount of damage to one of the "webs" where the waterjet broke-down.

30 American Chopper Paul Sr.'s POW MIA Leather Jack

Paul Sr. had this jacket custom-made prior to building the POW/MIA bike. Features an American flag patch on the right sleeve and "You Are Not Forgotten" on the back. He wore this jacket on episode 1 of the POW/MIA build, when the guys visited the Vietnam Wall in Washington, DC, as well in the Memorial Ride on episode 2 of the POW/MIA build (these episodes aired in January 2004). He continued to wear the jacket regularly long after those episodes. This jacket is of great sentimental value to Senior, as the POW/MIA bike is his favorite and most special bike. Autographed by Paul Senior. Size 58.

31 Custom Orange County Choppers Radio Controlled Hummer

RC Driver Magazine created this and presented it to the guys on an episode of American Chopper. In that episode, the guys are seen racing it around the old shop. It was also featured in an issue of the magazine along with an article on the Teutuls and OCC. Extensive customized details are cut into the metal work where it indicates that it was "Built for OCC 2004." Also cut into the metal are numerous figures which reflect the bike builds from the show such as a spider on web, a snowflake, a

star, the statue of liberty, snap-on, and many others. Paul Sr. and Paul Jr. have signed next to their pictures. 22 x 17 1/2 x 11

32 American Chopper Gillette Bike Stencil

This is a test piece for the Gillette Bike battery box (airing April 2005). An identical piece is now on the Gillette Bike. 5 x 1 1/2

33 Orange County Chopper "Freaked Out" Wheel

This wheel has the dubious honor of being the first wheel ever cut with OCC's water jet. Previously, wheels were cut by an outside vendor.

34 Autographed Rusty Wallace Jacket

Miller Lite jacket tailored to fit like a racing jacket and signed "Rusty Wallace #2." This item was donated when the Nascar drivers heard about this auction from the Teutuls during the NAPA Bike build. This item has been generously donated by Rusty Wallace.

35 Autographed Michael Waltrip Jacket

NAPA blue jacket signed "Michael Waltrip." This item was donated when the Nascar drivers heard about this auction from the Teutuls during the NAPA Bike build.

36 Autographed Rusty Wallace Jacket

Miller Lite jacket tailored to fit like a racing jacket and signed "Rusty Wallace #2." This item was donated when the Nascar drivers heard about this auction from the Teutuls during the NAPA Bike build. This item has been generously donated by Rusty Wallace.

37 Autographed Jimmie Johnson Gloves

Simpson driving gloves worn and signed by NASCAR driver "Jimmie Johnson." This item was donated when the Nascar drivers heard about this auction from the Teutuls during the NAPA Bike build.

38 OCC Webbed Tank from the Black Widow Bike

This is the Black Widow webbed tank that was mocked up and aired on American Chopper Episode 1. The webbed tank that is actually on the Black Widow Bike was not shown on the episode due to some errors by the original film crew. They were unable to use the footage of the original tank, so Paul Jr. had to mock up an identical tank for filming purposes only. This is the tank that was created for filming purposes and seen being created on the program. It is autographed by Paul Sr., Paul Jr., and Mikey.

39 Autographed Da Vinci Carburetor Poster

This is a poster of the first schematic of the Statue of Liberty Carburetor. This concept went on to be created and used on the Statue of Liberty Bike Episodes 1 & 2. It is signed by Paul Sr., Paulie, Mikey, Vinnie, Rick, and Cody.

40 NAPA Drag Bike Fiberglass Cowling

This piece of white fiberglass cowling was cut from the frame for the NAPA Drag Bike Build. This episode of American Chopper has not yet aired but is expected to show in June. Signed by Paul Sr., Paul Jr., and Mikey.

41 OCC Webbed Black Widow Front Fender

This is the actual Black Widow front fender that was shown on Episodes 1 & 2 being pieced by Paul Jr. The fender that was used on the bike was not shown on the program as there were some errors during the filming and the footage could not be processed.

42 OCC Black Widow Swing Arm

This is the actual Black Widow swing arm that was shown on Episodes 1 & 2 being created by Paul Jr. They were unable to use the footage of the actual swing arm that was used on the bike, so Paul Jr. was required to make an identical mock up that could be filmed and edited into the show.

43 American Chopper Caterpillar Rear Fender

This fender made a major appearance on Episode 1 of the Cat Bike. Mike Campo spent several days creating the fender, only to have Junior and the rest of the crew feel that it didn't fit the lines of the bike. Senior and Junior got into a major argument as to why Campo was assigned to work on the bike instead of Vinnie. They ended up agreeing that the fender didn't work, and threw it in the garbage. Sr. had to sit down w/ Campo and explain the situation. This was a very large segment on the Caterpillar Bike Build that recently aired. It is signed by Paul Sr., Paul Jr., and Mikey.

45 American Chopper POW/MIA Dogtag Mirror

This is the mirror created for the POW/MIA Bike. It was on the bike for a several weeks and shot in photographs of the bike. You will see it on Episodes 1 and 2 of POW/MIA Bike Build. It was later decided that the mirror was too big and Paul Sr. replaced it with something smaller.

47 Orange County Choppers Ford Excursion SUV

This vehicle is referred to as 'Flex' by the OCC crew. Funkmaster Flex 'tricked out' this Excursion on an episode of his show Rides with Funkmaster Flex. Flex came to the shop during an episode of American Chopper and presented the new vehicle to Paul Sr. It has been with the shop for over a year, being driven by many members of the OCC staff. It has a one of a kind paint job with barbed wire and two-tone maroon flames. There are DVD players inside and new chrome wheels.

48 Behind the Scenes Tour of American Chopper

The winner of this lot will have the opportunity to appear on a segment of Discovery Channel's American Chopper with Paul Senior, Paulie, Mikey, and the rest of the Orange County Choppers crew. immortalize yourself on one of the most popular shows on television today, while getting an insider's view of the inner workings of Orange County Choppers' famous shop in Montgomery, New York. Up to a total of four (minors must be accompanied by a parent or guardian) will be able to have a tour of the shop and hang-out with the guys during filming of the show.

49 Original David Mann Painting

49A Phil Mickelson Signed Master's Flag

Flag from the 2004 Master's Tournament signed by that year's winner, Phil Mickelson. This item has been generously donated by Davis Love III.

49B Davis Love III Autographed Poster

Autographed poster of Davis Love III from the 79th PGA Championship held at the Winged Foot Golf Club in 1997. This event was won by Davis Love, his first PGA Championship title, with an incredible five stroke victory over Justin Leonard. This item has been generously donated by Davis Love III. 18 x 24

49C Ryder Cup Signed Poster from 2001

This poster was printed for the 34th Ryder Cup Matches at The Belfry in Sutton Coldfield, England that was scheduled for September 28-30, 2001, but was postponed for one year due to the events of September 11, 2001. The poster is signed by the following players next to their pictures:

49F Motorcycle Collectors Cards

"Hot Bike-Street Chopper" complete set of motorcycle trading cards. Printed in the early 1970's, finding a complete set of the 66 cards produced is extremely rare. All are in mint or near mint condition. There are many great images of early choppers including close-ups of the original "Easy Rider" chopper and work by Arlen Ness. This collection was generously donated to the auction by Larry Schmidt of Houston, Texas.

49G Mickey Mantle Autographed Catalogue

In 2003, Guernsey's conducted the Mickey Mantle auction at Madison Square Garden. Representing the family of The Mick, the auction was enormously popular. Virtually all of the auction catalogues Guernsey's produced for the event were sold out and today command a premium on the collector's market. Just at the time of the auction, Mickey's sons discovered 102 portrait prints of their Dad that Mickey had personally autographed in felt marker. With the few remaining catalogues, the auction house created a special hardcover edition, inserting this actual autographed image of the baseball legend into the cover. Each copy of this deluxe limited catalogue is individually numbered, comes in a presentation slipcase, and includes a Certificate signed by Mantle's sons, David and Danny. The majority of the books were sold for substantial prices to auction participants. Guernsey's has donated number 92 of 95. Pictured here is the card signed by Mickey that has been bound into the cover.

49H Set of OCC Bike Plaques

Set of 23 Orange County Chopper Bike plaques including: Jet Bike, Black Widow Bike, Fire Bike, Cody Old School Project Bike (also signed by Cody), Comanche Bike, Mikey's Bike, Snap-On Bike, New York Jets Bike, POW/MIA Bike, Liberty Bike, Dixie Chopper Bike, Christmas Bike, Mikey & Vinnie Bike (also signed by Vinnie), I, Robot Bike, Davis Love III Bike, Lance Armstrong Livestrong Bike, Police Bike, David Mann Bike, Santa's Sleigh Bike, Carroll Shelby Bike, Lincoln Mark LT Bike, Junior's Dream Bike, and The CAT Bike.

50 American Chopper Paul Senior Old School Chopper

For the first time since the show began Paul Senior and Paulie will each create and follow their own vision for a chopper. The results of the builds, to be televised on future episodes of American Chopper, are the heart of the "Orange County Choppers Support Our Troops" auction. Each of the bikes will represent the vision and direction of its creator.

As fans of the show, we know that sometimes it is a bit difficult to know exactly what Senior has in mind. His vision is clear and right before him, but it takes the rest of us a while to get with the program! What we do know is that he plans to build his vision of a traditional old-school chopper. The winner of this lot will have a Paul Senior custom-crafted motorcycle.
