COULD the next stop on the Bennifer 2.0 love tour be her palatial estate in the Hamptons? Spies there say there's been feverish activity at **Jennifer Lopez**'s Water Mill estate, with crews sprucing up the grounds, testing the security system and bringing in a fleet of Range Rovers and a boat. Meanwhile, a source told People **Ben Affleck** and Lopez "are discussing summer plans," and that they "want to spend as much time together as possible." Lopez bought the eight-bedroom, 7½-bath manse for \$10 million in 2013, when she told Hola magazine it was her "dream home." Built in 2004, the gated property offers lots of privacy and sits on 3 acres. It includes a spa, office, guest house, media room, sauna, study, outdoor shower and heated pool. The home has been regularly featured on Lopez's Instagram, and last summer she spent a lot of time there with her twins, **Max** and **Emme**, and then-fiancé, **Alex Rodriguez**. Lopez and Affleck were last spotted on Friday night on a date in Beverly Hills, where they dined in a private room for two hours. Reps for Lopez and Affleck didn't get back to us.
